COLONOSCOPY CHECKLIST

Start anti-inflammatory/analgesic therapy straight away and continue for 1-2 weeks Affected joints should be rested, elevated and kept cool Avoid trauma to the affected joint and consider the use of an ice pack or bed-cage [2] [3] 1st line: NSAIDs continued for 24-48 hrs after attack has resolved There is no evidence to suggest 1 NSAID is more effective than another NSAIDs benefit from

Diet can influence acne High glycaemic index (GI) diets (eg sugar and sugary foods, white bread, potatoes, white rice etc) have been shown to cause or aggravate acne Switching to a low GI diet may lead to fewer spots There is also some evidence that consuming milk and dairy products may trigger acne in some people, but this hasn't been studied in as much detail yet Most acne sufferers
