A hernia of the abdominal wall is a bulging of the abdominal contents through an area of weakness in the wall An abdominal wall hernia can be small and simple or large and complex Many hernias do not cause symptoms, but some may cause pain If you have symptoms like pain and you would like your hernia repaired then we can consider this

Recovering from Major Abdominal Surgery

After major abdominal surgery with a large incision it takes about two to three months to be able to move around comfortably If you have had complex keyhole surgery your recovery will be quicker If you have had a large incision in your abdomen you should avoid lifting anything heavier than 2-3kg This is about the weight of a full kettle A

Botox Prior to Abdominal Wall Reconstruction Author: Surgical Care Practitioner Repair of large complex hernias can be extremely challenging By injecting Botox before your surgery it will:- Lengthen the abdominal muscles therefore reducing the size of the hernia defect by (30 - 50%) allowing the surgeons to bring these muscles back to the midline Reduce muscle tension following your
